The following must be submitted along with the completed application:

- A 500-word essay detailing why the applicant should be awarded the scholarship and how they intend to positively impact society through a career in law enforcement.
- An official copy of the applicant's most recent high school or college transcript.
- Contact information for the applicant's College Student Account Manager.
- A Letter of Recommendation not from a family member
- List of any academic awards and recognitions.
- List of community or civic involvements.
- List of extracurricular activities
